

Industry Outlook¹¹

- Employment of private detectives and investigators is expected to grow faster than the average from 2022 to 2032.
- Employment in the protective service field is also projected to grow, creating about 3,800 openings each year throughout the decade.
- Some federal agencies and police departments require college experience and a significant number of applicants for entry-level police jobs are college graduates.
- Heightened security concerns, the increased need to protect confidential information and property, and continued demand for public safety are likely to continue driving growth in this field.
